



On-Resistance vs. Drain Current




 $\rm T_J$ - Junction Temperature (°C) **On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature**







Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage

Single Pulse Power, Junction-to-Ambient









It is used to determine the current rating, when this rating falls below the package limit
