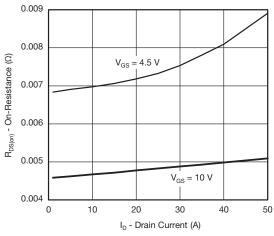

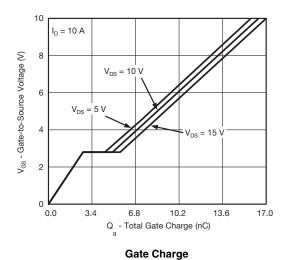

On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage

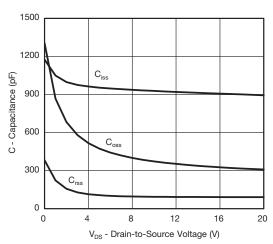

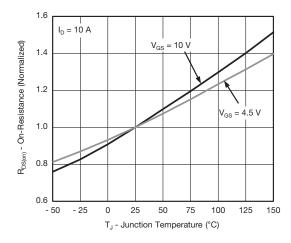

V<sub>GS</sub> - Gate-to-Source Voltage (V) **Transfer Characteristics** 



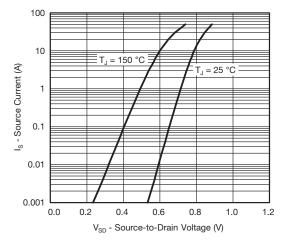

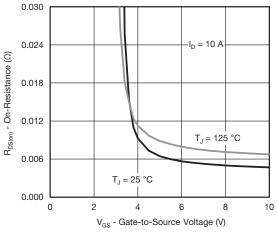
On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature

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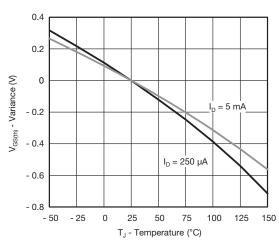

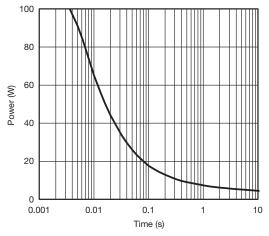
Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage



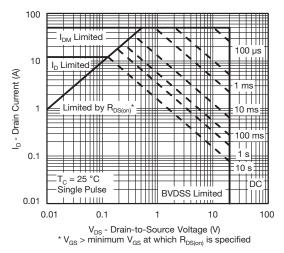
On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage



Threshold Voltage



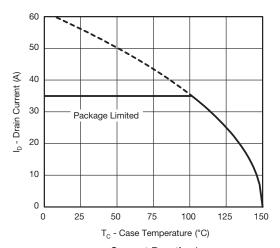
Single Pulse Power (Junction-to-Ambient)



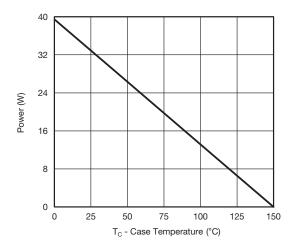
Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient



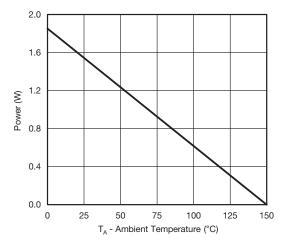

Power Derating, Junction-to-Case



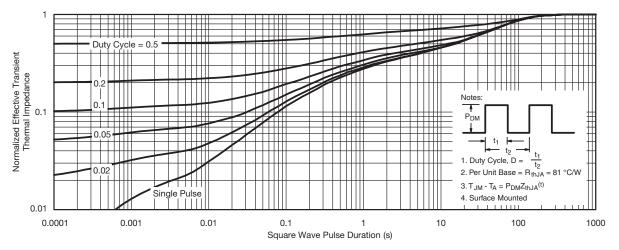

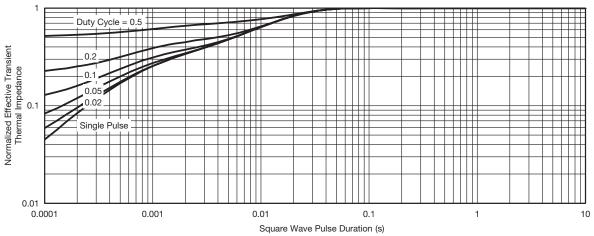
