# N-Channel 80 V (D-S) MOSFET

#### **DESCRIPTION**


The attached SPICE model describes the typical electrical characteristics of the n-channel vertical DMOS. The subcircuit model is extracted and optimized over the -55 °C to 125 °C temperature ranges under the pulsed 0 V to 10 V gate drive. The saturated output impedance is best fit at the gate bias near the threshold voltage.

A novel gate-to-drain feedback capacitance network is used to model the gate charge characteristics while avoiding convergence difficulties of the switched  $C_{\rm gd}$  model. All model parameter values are optimized to provide a best fit to the measured electrical data and are not intended as an exact physical interpretation of the device.


