


Gate Current vs. Gate-Source Voltage














Gate Charge




Source Drain Diode Forward Voltage




Threshold Voltage



On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature




On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage




Drain Source Breakdown vs. Junction Temperature


Safe Operating Area

The data are extracted from single pulse transient thermal impedance characteristics which are developed from empirical measurements. The latter is valid for the part mounted on printed circuit board FR4, size 1" x 1" x 0.062", double sided with 2 oz. copper, 100 % on both sides. The part capabilities can widely vary depending on actual application parameters and operating conditions.
