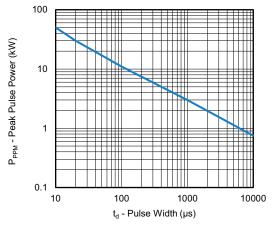


Fig. 1 - Peak Pulse Power Rating Curve

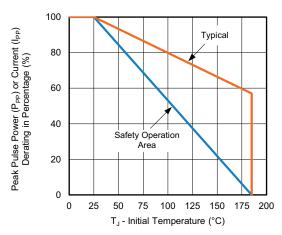


Fig. 2 - Pulse Power or Current vs. Initial Junction Temperature

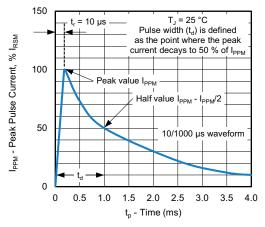


Fig. 3 - Pulse Waveform

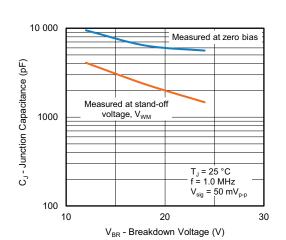


Fig. 4 - Typical Junction Capacitance

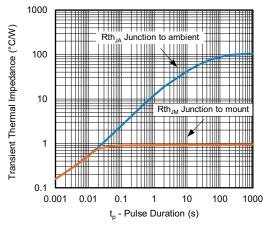


Fig. 5 - Typical Transient Thermal Impedance

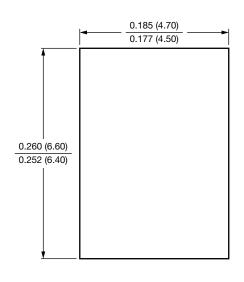
· Fig. 1, power calculations is based on I<sub>PPM</sub> times defined maximum clamping voltage by pulse width

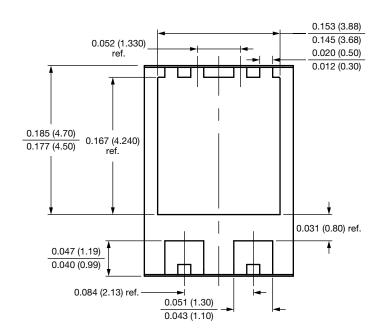

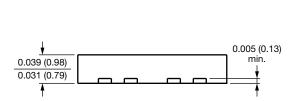


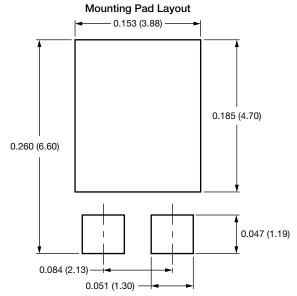
